Robert's Research Reflections, Ruminations, and Rules of Order (N=7)

- Get a mentor, and then, become one.
- □ Try to be part of a stable research team.
- Be alert to the "iatrogenic effects" of research.
- Set out to do research that matters.
- Remember that contributing to research is a two-way street.
- □ Do more than "just think" about the practical meaning of your research.
- □ As much as possible, avoid needless complexity in writing and reporting of research results.
